ABOUT LEEDS HERITAGE THEATRES

Leeds Heritage Theatres (LHT) is Leeds Grand Theatre, City Varieties Music Hall and Hyde Park Picture House. A charitable trust, together we are united by a single cause; to bring people together, create the extraordinary and provide a positive environment in which to entertain and educate.

Leeds Grand Theatre

Built in 1878 by architect George Corson, Leeds Grand Theatre is a major milestone in Victorian design; famed for its sumptuous interior, plasterwork and other decorative features.

Seating 1466 at full capacity, the auditorium provides a home for performances of all types, including its resident companies Opera North and Northern Ballet. Since its Heritage Lottery Fund and Arts Council supported ‘transformation’ in 2006, the theatre has hosted the best of the West End and other touring productions, including large musicals, drama from the National Theatre, comedians and music. The theatre played host to the world premieres of Gary Barlow and Tim Firth’s, *The Girls* (2015), and Kay Mellor’s *Fat Friends The Musical* (2017) and *Band of Gold* (2019).

City Varieties Music Hall

Recognised by the Guinness World Records as the nation’s longest-running music hall, The Varieties is Leeds’ oldest theatre, beginning life in 1865 as a room above a pub, established for the working class.

Widely known as the home of the BBC’s *Good Old Days* from 1953-83, The Varieties’ stage has welcomed many of the world’s greatest entertainers, from Harry Houdini and Lilly Langtree to John Bishop and Russell Crowe.

Following major restoration work (2009-11), The Varieties is still regarded as one of the nation’s best venues for live comedy, music and variety, plus National Theatre live and delayed screenings and the hugely popular Rock ‘n’ Roll Pantos that showcase the very best of live actor/musicians in a break from the traditional pantomime.

Hyde Park Picture House

First opened in 1914, the Grade II listed Picture House is one of the UK’s oldest cinemas.

Beginning its life shortly before the outbreak of the First World War, it gained popularity by screening patriotic dramas and newsreels to boost morale during the action. Surviving the advent of ‘talkies’ in the 1920s, The Picture House continues to screen the very best independent, art house and classic films from around the world, as well as special live events with filmmakers, artists and academics.

Today, the cinema still attracts devoted visitors and counts some famous faces amongst its fans, including patron, BAFTA-nominated writer and director of the acclaimed 2017 hit *God’s Own Country*, Francis Lee, plus Hollywood actor Chris Pine (*Star Trek*), and broadcaster and film critic Mark Kermode.

In June 2023, The Picture House reopened following the completion of a major redevelopment project. Alongside vital conservation work, we also introduced new accessible facilities including a second screen, ramped entrance, expanded foyer, new Cafe Bar and Community Room.

UK THEATRES 10 PRINCIPLES FOR SAFE AND INCLUSIVE WORKSPACES

1. Everyone is responsible for creating and maintaining an inclusive workplace that is positive and supportive.

7. We value inclusivity, appreciate difference, encourage self-education and consider people equal without prejudice or favour. We build relationships based on mutual respect. We will all work to give and receive feedback in a constructive way, which we know will improve creativity and productivity.
8. We understand that reporting bullying, harassment or discrimination can be intimidating. If anyone comes forward to report any of this behaviour, we will endeavour to make the process of reporting clear and straightforward, investigate objectively and respect confidentiality where possible. Individuals who have made complaints or participate in good faith in any investigation into bullying, harassment, or discrimination should not suffer any form of reprisal or victimisation as a result.
9. We will respect each other's dignity and differences, regardless of the seniority of our role in an organisation.
10. As we continually work to better understand, develop and deliver this work, those of us who are employers commit to paying professionals with lived experience and/or specialist knowledge in these areas to advise us.

LHT is a PiPA (Parents and Carers in Performing Arts) partner.
